FOR SMALL BUSINESSES



Supporting Our Local Economy

The City of Burien will launch a fourth round of small business grants to support the continuing recovery of our vibrant small business community. Grants will help to mitigate potential job losses, business closures, decline in sales tax revenue, and loss of goods and services to the community caused by the economic and public health impacts of the COVID pandemic.

There are funds for up to 35 eligible businesses grants of \$5,000 will be offered. The application portal opens **Tuesday, October 24, and closes Tuesday, November 14 2023.**

Eligibility Requirements



Employees

Have ten or fewer FTE employees on the business payroll at the time of grant application.



Duration

Must have been in business for at least the last 24 months within the City of Burien.



Revenue Loss

Have experienced a 25% decline in gross revenue.



Physical Storefront

Be a "brick and mortar business" with a physical location in Burien or be a "home-based" childcare business.
